

# SHIPSHEWANA AMISH QUILT

## Section 2

### Cutting for Star Block:

Background fabric-

Cut five 4 1/2" squares

Cut one 5 1/4 square and cut diagonally both ways to yield 4 triangles.

Star fabric-

Cut two 5 1/4" squares and cut diagonally both ways to yield 8 triangles.

Accent fabric-

Cut one 5 1/4" square and cut diagonally both ways to yield 4 triangles.

### Piecing of Star Block:

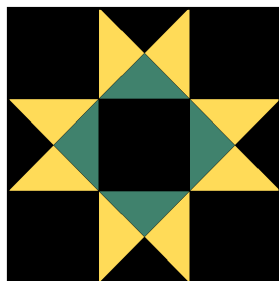
- Using the background, star and accent triangles, sew together four units that look like this -



- The block is then sewn in rows with the background squares.



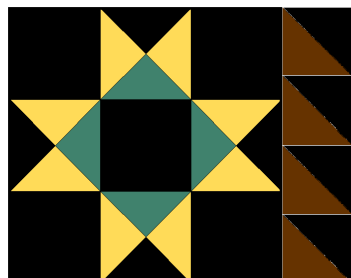
- Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Construct four 3" (finished size) half square triangles. Sew together in a strip and add to the right side of the star block unit. For the half square triangles, cut two 3 7/8" squares from each color. Sub-cut diagonally one ways to yield 4 triangles. Sew opposite colors together along the long edge.



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
