

Midget Blocks—Block 108

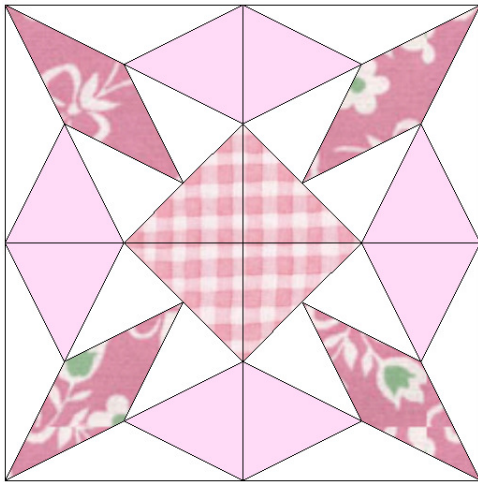
Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a variety of print fabrics and the background fabric.

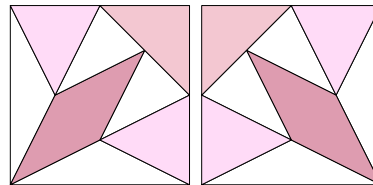
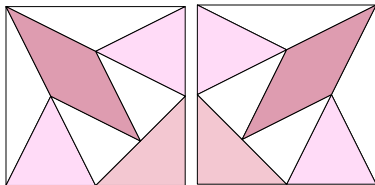
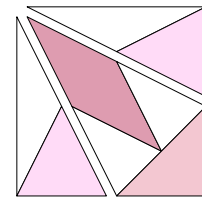
Lucky Star- 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the first block from the left in the ninth row.

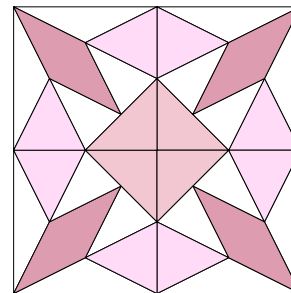
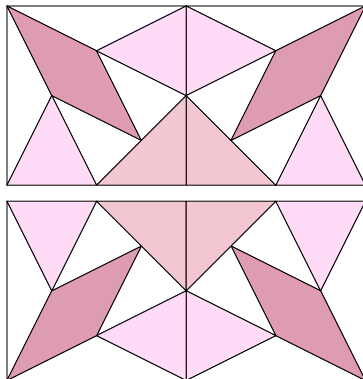
This block is well suited for foundation piecing



- Foundation piece units A through L
- Sew unit A and C to B
- Repeat sewing D and F to E / sew G and I to H / sew J and K to L
- Sew the quarter block sections together



- Sew the two sections together across the middle seam to complete the block



Your unfinished block should measure 5"



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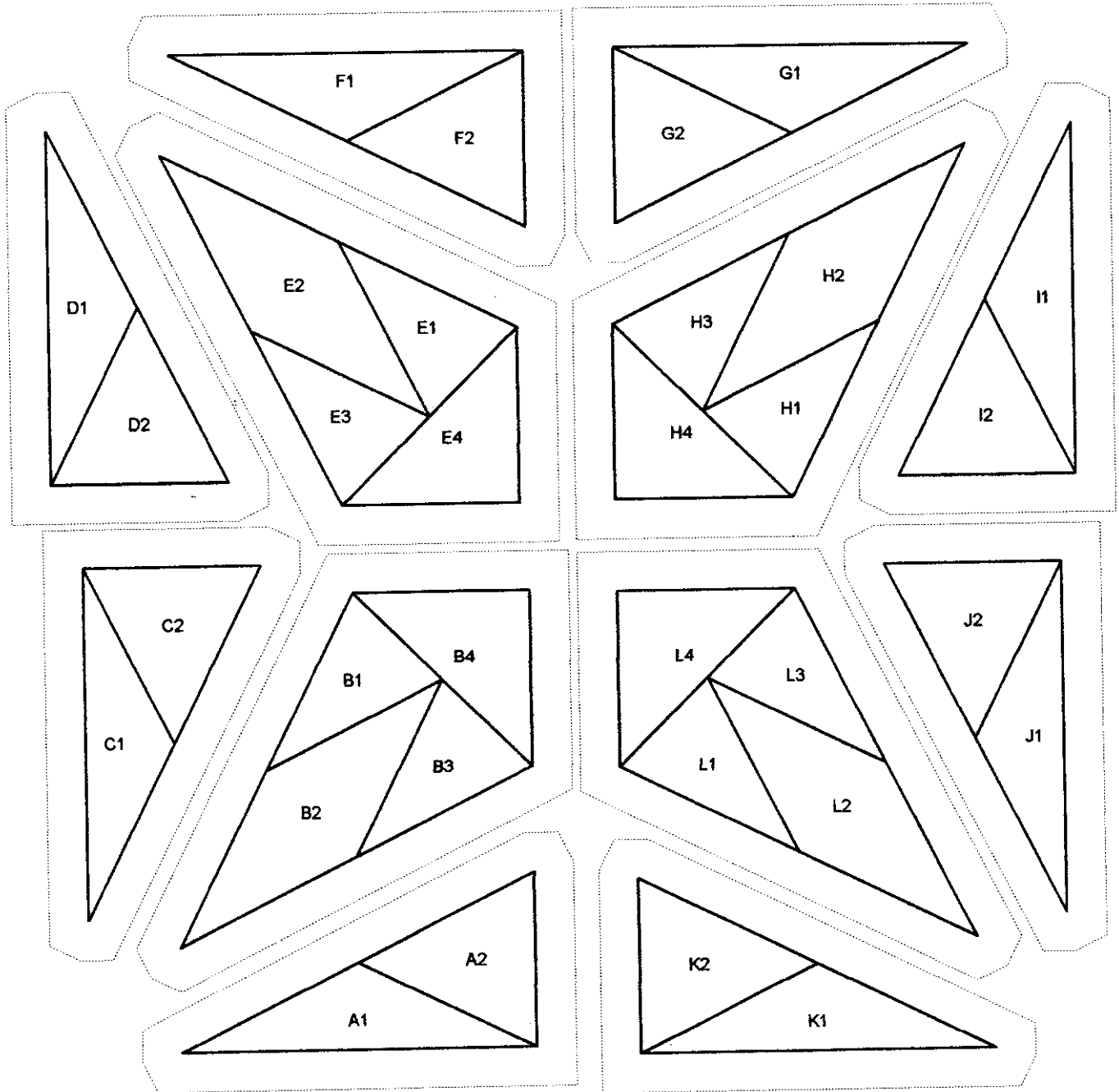
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This line should
